ELIGIBILITY

- Newly admitted to the Mechanical or Aerospace Engineering Ph.D. program at Missouri S&T
- Be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Minimum 3.5/4.0 GPA (undergraduate or master's) upon application
