Job Description

The Department of Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering at the Missouri University of Science and Technology (Missouri S&T) in Rolla, Missouri is seeking outstanding applicants for tenure-track Aerospace Engineering faculty positions open at the assistant professor rank. Applicants are sought who can apply their expertise to relevant aerospace disciplines including the program's research thrust areas of Hypersonics, Intelligent and Autonomous Systems for Aerial and/or Space Vehicles, Aerospace Structures, Flight Dynamics and Control, Space Systems, and Propulsion.

Requirements

Applicants should have demonstrated excellence in research and provide evidence of potential for excellence in (a) establishing a strong, externally funded research program, (b) high-quality teaching at the undergraduate and graduate levels, (c) service in the applicant's professional community and our institution, and (d) increasing the diversity of the student body and faculty. Qualified candidates will possess a Ph.D. in Aerospace Engineering or a closely related field.

- 3) Research statement that describes your current work and your future research goals (2 pages max.);
- 4) Teaching statement that describes your teaching experience, your teaching interests, and your philosophy of teaching (2 pages max.);
