- Newly admitted to the Mechanical or Aerospace Engineering Ph.D. program at Missouri S&T
- Be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Minimum 3.75/4.0 CGPA (undergraduate or master's) upon application

- 50% FTE support (\$24,000 annual stipend) plus \$10,000 annual fellowship support for up to five years
